If you go down to the woods today ... Teddy Bears' Picnic in Savages Wood

On Wednesday 12th June, pre-schoolers and their families were invited to a come on a bear hunt!

The rain kindly stopped for long enough to hold the Teddy Bear's Picnic in Savages Wood. The picnic had a 'Going on a Bear Hunt' theme with children creating their own 'Bear Hunt' books, listening to the story (whilst learning some Makaton signs to help retell it) and exploring a bear hunt trail around the woods. Tesco kindly donated biscuits and squash so we could share a snack with the children.

The picnic was organised by the Bradley Stoke Early Years Learning Community, a group of pre-school and reception teachers from across Bradley Stoke and the surrounding areas, working in partnership with the South Gloucestershire Early Years' Team, and is part of a bigger project focusing on transition from pre-school into reception.

The project has gained sponsorship from a number of companies; Andrews Estate Agents, The Willow Brook

Centre and Taylor-Wimpey; all of which have donated funds that have enabled the purchase of sets of books and production of a leaflet of nursery rhymes to share with children.

Children attending the pre-schools working on the project will be sharing the stories and rhymes over the next term (We're Going on a Bear Hunt, The Gingerbread Man, The Little Red Hen, The 3 Billy



Goats Gruff and Max the Brave) and their reception teachers will also have a pack of the same books to share with them when they join their new schools in September. The aim is to encourage language development through the learning of the rhymes and stories and support the transition for children as they will hear stories and rhymes they are familiar with when they start in their new classes.

As a group of schools and pre-schools, Bradley Stoke Early Years Learning Community group has been working together for a number of years to strengthen the links between the settings so that all can work together to ensure our children get a great start to their early education.

Popular Three Brooks Local Nature Reserve receives £25,000 grant for accessibility improvements

A project to improve access to the Three Brooks Local Nature Reserve in Bradley Stoke has been given a boost, thanks to a grant of £25,000 from Enovert Community Trust.

Three Brooks is a popular Nature Reserve covering 60 hectares of tranquil woodland and meadows and lies at the heart of the town. Some of the woodland dates back over 400 years, with a rich mix of habitats that provide valuable food and shelter to a wide range of wildlife, including great crested newts and slow worms.

The project will see more than 500m of woodland paths upgraded at the northern end of the reserve in Savages Woods to improve accessibility. An environmentally friendly, no-dig cell web system will be used for the paths to protect surrounding tree roots.

Robin Jones, Chair of The Three Brooks Nature Conservation Group which is delivering the project, said:

"In recent years the popularity of the site has been causing issues, especially in winter when the main unsurfaced paths have become water logged and unusable.

"The project to resurface the woodland footpath network will greatly improve accessibility for visitors, while helping to protect ground flora and tree roots from trampling. We hope the upgraded paths will enable more people to use the area, which will lead to a greater understanding and appreciation of the natural environment."

Angela Haymonds, Trust Secretary at Enovert Community Trust, said: "Three Brooks Nature Reserve provides the community of Bradley Stoke with vital access to the natural environment. As a popular public open space, accessibility is key to ensuring year-round access for local residents. The Trustees are delighted to provide this grant towards the footpath improvement project, which will encourage greater use of the reserve."

Easily one of the best parts of my job is meeting up with local residents to share a happy story. It was an absolute pleasure therefore to share

The couple have lived in Stoke Gifford for nearly 40 years, and prior to that spent 10 years plus in Little Stoke.



Keeping it in the family, son David also works for Airbus, having spent the last 14 years based in Toulouse. Their daughter remains local, living with her family in Bradley Stoke. The couple are very active in the local community, with Brian enjoying short mat bowls and skittles and Margaret a member of the local WI for over 20 years as well as the local flower arranging group. They both enjoy line dancing, active walks and also volunteer for the National Trust at Dyrham Park. "We are very fortunate to have been blessed with good health".

Brian and Margaret have enjoyed lots of travel over the years including trips to India, Egypt, Jordan, a Nile cruise, Mediterranean cruise and a cruise to see the Northern Lights to name a few; but one trip raises a special memory. "All the kids nowadays seem to have this gap year - we never had such a thing in our time, so we thought why not go now! So in our 70s we spent some time island hoping around the Greek islands, not knowing where we were heading or where we were staying the night!" Margaret said "Brian told me I could only take the clothes I could carry in the backpack on my back! Not the way a lady usually travels!" It sounds like they had a great trip.

To celebrate their Diamond Wedding, the couple held a big party for family and friends in Iron Acton hall, where they were entertained by a local disco, Euphorix, and a Neil Diamond tribute act. A BBQ for neighbours is also planned.

"We had so many presents and cards and I would really like to thank everyone who helped us celebrate. We asked for donations to charity in lieu of presents and are both astounded to have raised £300 - we never had any idea it would be that much. We have long supported the Charlton Farm Children's Hospice, so some of the money will be sent to them and some to the Air Ambulance. As a family we have been extremely blessed not to have needed either of these great charities. Even with a vivid imagination, I cannot think what anguish parents must go through who outlive their child. We are so grateful not to have



needed that support but their work is so important to those that do need them."

The key to 60 years of marriage?

"I can't believe we've been married for 60 years. If someone asked me I'd say it felt more like 25, time has just flown" said Margaret, "but that's life".

return to festival

report from Graham Baker, BSTC Youth **Development & Participation Worker**

In recent years, Bradley Stoke Festival has seen our Town Council youth work team and local young people work together to organise an extremely successful two-day package of activities.

Saturday saw the return of our popular Street Art Workshops and the King Ramps Skate Halfpipe, with 'have a go sessions' and pro rider demos throughout the day. Strong winds presented an initial challenge setting up, especially building our 8ft x 16ft Art wall, however, once up, the wall offered a useful windbreak for our art workshop activities. The art workshops involved children and young people painting a 4ft x 2ft board with the support of professional artists, youth workers and volunteers and the gueues soon started to build. Due to demand we continued until 6pm and sadly still had to turn people away; however, about 70 participants happily returned home clutching their original works of art.

Meanwhile, spectators gathered for regular pro rider demos on the half pipe with popular 'have a go' ride sessions for local young people. In addition, we promoted our usual Youth Work activities, but the gusty winds prevented our usual displays.

On Sunday we relocated to the Skatepark with the Skate Halfpipe being set up alongside the park to provide important extra capacity. Soon, about 60 competitors,



What can I do for my lower back pain?

You may feel like resting, but activity is good. Louise, Physiotherapist at Bradley Stoke Physio & Health, shares some exercises to help your lower back pain.

We talk about low back pain a lot – it is a very common complaint. Fortunately, lots of people can help (you'll have seen us talk about our Osteopath and Physio-led Pilates, for example), and there's much you can do to help yourself recover.

It is surprisingly difficult to damage your spine. An episode of back pain is seldom an indication that something dreadful has happened. Our spines are very strong and resilient. They're also designed to move, and all evidence suggests that the sooner you get on with doing things, the better you'll feel. Moving prevents your back seizing up and will help ease the pain.

Start with activities that don't put too much strain on your back. Try these (photos right) - see our website for my video of these exercises.

To help you keep moving, you might find it useful to use something to help control your pain. Self-help remedies include:

- 'Over the counter' pain killers, or ask your GP, Nurse Practitioner or Pharmacist for the best medication for you
- Using heat or ice on the area in which you feel pain
- Relaxation techniques

Lower back pain can take time to disappear. If you've kept moving and it doesn't settle after 3-4 weeks, it's a good idea to make an appointment with a Physiotherapist. A Physio will assess you, can use manual therapy, and will prescribe stretches and core strengthening exercises, to help treat your back. Come to us, or your GP, sooner if you are concerned.

Remember, the main message is that your pain is unlikely to be because of something serious. Keeping active, staying strong and remaining flexible is the way to tackle it.

Government confirms plans to introduce 'no-fault' divorce

Last month the Government set out its proposals for reforming our 50-year-old divorce law which has been shown to exacerbate conflict.

Justice Secretary David Gauke said: "While we will always uphold the institution of marriage, it cannot be right that our outdated law creates or increases conflict between divorcing couples.

"So I have listened to calls for reform and firmly believe now is the right time to end this unnecessary blame game for good."

The current legal basis

In order to obtain a divorce a Petitioner has to prove that their marriage has irretrievably broken down by reference to one of five statutory factors. These are:

- · Adultery (fault based).
- Unreasonable behaviour (fault based)
- Two years' desertion (fault based)
- Two years' separation with the other spouses' consent (separation based)
- · Five years' separation, no consent required (separation based).

Owens v Owens

In 2016, a judge in the Central Family Court refused to grant Mrs Owens a decree nisi of divorce, even though the judge had ruled her marriage to her husband had broken down.

Mr Owens defended the divorce (a rare occurrence in practice) and the judge found that Mrs Owens had failed to prove that her husband had behaved in such a way that she could not reasonably be expected to live with him.

Mrs Owens appealed first to the Court of Appeal, who dismissed the appeal, and then to the Supreme Court.

In 2018, the Supreme Court unanimously dismissed that appeal and the outcome left Mrs Owens trapped in her marriage. This made headline news and reinvigorated the calls for "nofault" divorce to end the blame game.

"No-fault" divorce - proposed reforms to help reduce family conflict

Following reform, the five 'facts' would be removed - a couple or one party will only have to state that the marriage has broken down irretrievably.

It will also remove the ability for one person to contest a divorce and introduces a minimum timeframe of six months from petition to divorce.

Among others, advocates of "no-fault" divorce include some senior members of the Judiciary, the Family



Mediation Taskforce. Resolution (the national organisation of family lawyers) and the Law Society.

Parallel changes will be made to the law governing the dissolution of a civil partnership which broadly mirrors the legal process for obtaining a divorce.

Should I wait for no-fault divorce to become law?

You may be waiting some time – the legislation is expected to be introduced "as soon as parliamentary time allows."



Bradley Stoke Youth FC (BSYFC) Football Festival 2019

On Saturday 8th June 2019, Bradley Stoke Youth FC continued the success of their Football Festival at the Jubilee Centre which attracted 130 School children (Year 1) representing 13 different local schools.

The Festival is the culmination of the School Link Program where BSYFC FA Qualified coaches go into the 13 schools and provide football coaching to all Year 1 children over a 3 week period. The program starts in February and finishes in May ready for the Festival in June.

The Football Festival has been running since 2006 and over the years has developed into a major part of the Bradley Stoke Town Community Festival. To date, over 1,900 children have now taken part. The School Link Program started in 2007 and has grown over the years to a major community activity with over 8,000 children having received football skills coaching in their school.

The Festival and the School Link Program is free of charge to all schools, and the Festival provides an opportunity for children to play games of non-competitive football in a safe environment. Each school receives a cup which can be kept for a year, and is awarded on a points-scoring system based on things such as; attitude and approach of players and teachers, preparation and organisation, adhering to the guidelines and ensuring both boys and girls of all abilities are selected. The whole day is about participation and enjoyment to allow each child the opportunity to play football in a friendly environment.

Every child receives a medal and gift bag full of football related essentials like shin pads, football socks, water bottle, baseball cap, activity play pack and sweets. As well as the cup, each school receives a bag of size 3 footballs to continue the football coaching at their school. The winning school also receives a new kit for their team.

The Teacher Awards this year went to Baileys Court and St Peters.

For the 13th consecutive year, Sole Sisters organised the Bradley Stoke 10K which has now become an integral part of the festival weekend. With an entry limit of 650 runners, the race sold out in record time this

From 6.00 am on the Sunday. members of Sole Sisters were either getting the Jubilee Centre set-up as Race HQ or were out on the course delivering the water, putting up warning signs ready and generally getting ready for 8.00 am when the runners started arriving to pick up their race numbers.

Six lead marshals gathered their own group of mile marshals, all equipped with goodie bags, who set-off to their marshal stations covering the entire 10KM (6 mile) route. Each year, we need between 80 - 100 marshals for the event and that includes two water stations. As with previous years, we've received such lovely feedback on how great and supportive our marshals were. 


