

Green Dog Walkers Scheme -A friendly way to tackle dog fouling issues

We have recently signed up to the Green Dog Walkers Scheme.



The idea is that responsible dog owners sign a pledge to say that they will clear up after their dogs and will carry spare bags with them which they will offer to anyone they see not clearing up. They will wear a very distinct arm band to identify them as a Green Dog Walker. This is a nonconfrontational friendly way



to approach those who haven't cleared up after their dog.

A friendly reminder ...

Green Dog Walkers is a non-confrontational. friendly way to change attitudes about dog fouling.

What's the Green Armband for?

If you see someone wearing the Green Dog Walkers armband, it means that they have "Taken the Pledge"

- to always clean up after their dog
- to carry extra doggie bags
- to gladly give you a bag for your dog-just ask

Brief for Potential Operators of New Community Centre at Highbrook Park



Stoke Gifford Parish Councillors are currently looking into the design, services and potential takeover of a new Community Centre being built east of Harry Stoke Road. Stoke Gifford.

A working group has been set up and regular meetings are taking place with architects and members of the design team from South Glos Council.

Background

Highbrook Park is a Crest Nicolson development of up to 1,200 new homes, a primary school, children's nursery, public open space, a community centre and retail units. Consent has been granted for 1,192 dwellings and for some of the supporting infrastructure, including the community centre. To date 166 dwellings are built and occupied.



The approved planning layout shows the community centre in a prominent location on The Boulevard, close to bus stops, shops, shared parking, nursery and a primary school with a

multi-use games area. There will be an enclosed outside space for users of the facility adjacent to the building, and parking between the community centre and the primary school site.

The Headline Specification describes the spaces and facilities required which include a hall suitable for cultural events, separate meeting rooms, fully fitted kitchen to catering standard, managers office, reception area, cleaner's cupboard, WCs and changing rooms, bin store, external space and parking.

It was back in March 2013 that Matters Magazines first paid a visit to the North Bristol foodbank headquarters on Filton Avenue, during their first full year in operation.

As a result of this meeting, our community magazines worked with local schools to run an Easter appeal. I am delighted to report that many of our local schools still organise large collections over Harvest and Easter, in fact, the foodbank told me out of all the schools across Bristol that generously make collections for the charity, it is the schools in the Bradley Stoke, Little Stoke Gifford and Winterbourne areas that donate the most.

It was good to meet with the dedicated North Bristol foodbank team again, who are still working tirelessly for local families. foodbank Manager Matt Dobson took some time out to bring me up to date.

In 2018 the North Bristol foodbanks (Yate, Thornbury, Filton, Horfield, Lockleaze, Patchway, Mangotsfield and Southmead) fed 6,961 people (individuals helped not the number of food packages). In 2019, the same food banks fed 9,500 people, up a staggering 40% from 2018. These figures make tough reading.

A large part of this increase is due to the roll-out of Universal Credit, that sees people have a 5-week waiting period for benefits to come through when they apply or have a change in circumstance.

Matt told me that foodbanks do not want to exist! They will of course not leave people vulnerable who are in the midst of a crisis but a large part of what they do is campaigning to make much needed changes to our welfare state.

The Trussell Trust, who the foodbank is associated with, currently has a campaign Five Weeks Too Long that it would be great if you could support. It only takes a minute to sign up at - www.trusselltrust. org/five-weeks-too-long.



So how does the Foodbank system work?

Step 1: Nonperishable food is donated by the public.

Step 2: Volunteers sort and pack food into emergency food boxes.

Step 3: Frontline care professionals such as doctors and social workers give Foodbank vouchers to people in crisis.

Step 4: Foodbank vouchers are exchanged for 3 days of food at a Foodbank.

Step 5: Foodbank staff take time to listen and signpost clients to further support.

The rise in living costs is another key contributor. Rent prices in Bristol and surrounding areas are through the roof. Matt told me that many families find that after paying their rent and fuel costs they only have £20 leftover to cover everything else.

The team is also seeing a sharp rise in people with mental health issues, so as well as offering food, they are working hard to help get them to the right people or organisations to support their overall welfare.

The foodbanks take time to talk with people about their individual circumstances and signpost them to the relevant advice centres etc. They currently work with 320 referral agencies.

I asked Matt if the rise in the use of the foodbanks had helped lift the stigma that can come with using these facilities? He told me that, although some press outlets report that 'of course people are going to want to take advantage of free food', that is not the case at all; many are still reluctant. He had met with a lady that week who had been given a food voucher three weeks previously; she had been back and forth in front of the doors of the foodbank but wasn't able to bring herself to go in. When she eventually did, she was relieved and pleased to be met with such a warm, considerate welcome.

Matt explained that people from any walk of life can find themselves in crisis and the foodbanks are here to offer help and support without any judgement.

"We are always so blown away by the support of our local community. We couldn't run foodbank without the people and business owners that live and work in our community. Not only is the physical support through food and financial donations invaluable, but the picture this shows our city of a community uniting together to support the most vulnerable is incredibly powerful"

How can you help?

- Make regular donations of one or two of the items listed (this can cost less than a £1!) to a local drop-off point.
- Support the 5 Week Too long campaign and put pressure on your local MPs by writing to them to demand change to the welfare state.
- Make a financial donation to ensure this good-work can continue.
- Could your local business or community venue become a collection
- Run a fundraiser at a community group or place of work.

The foodbank always welcomes new local groups or businesses to set up as collection points or run fundraiser events; do get in touch with them on the contact details below if you would like any further information on how to go about this.

The North Bristol Foodbank is thankful that they are currently well-covered with 200-300 volunteers that work across the outlets each week.

Matt told me that, although the work is incredibly challenging and the foodbanks are sorry that they have to exist, joy comes from the the incredible support that the community shows the project, it's a community behind a community.














"He is not here; he has risen!"

When I was 19 I went on a gap year trip to Bolivia with an organisation called Latin Link where small teams were allocated to various building projects throughout the country. We were charged with helping to build a swimming pool in a children's summer camp 50 miles from the capital La Paz in the high altitude foothills of the Andes.

With absolutely no building experience whatsoever we were probably more a liability than a help and yet our foreman, Omar, took us on with consummate grace and humour. Once I wasted half a ton of cement by mixing it incorrectly, but Omar saved my blushes by saying to the whole team that it was a 'dodgy bag' in the first place. He was a great man and we grew to love him.

One morning when the rest of the team were out, he burst into our dormitory saying 'my daughter is dying'. As my friend Nick and I ran up the path towards his tiny, corrugated roofed house, we were stopped by the appearance of Omar's wife weeping outside. She looked at us and shook her head, and with that Omar slumped to the floor, his worst fears realised. The baby girl had died. Numb, we stepped into that shack to verify the death, and then hurriedly left them to their grief, mumbling well-meaning platitudes as we passed. It was, and is, a familiar scene of grief, repeated in countless homes, in every country throughout the world. Inevitably it is the strongest memory I have of that whole trip.

I often think about this moment when I read about the women approaching the tomb in the Easter story told in Luke's gospel. They had seen Jesus die, agonisingly on a cross, and with bleary-eyed grief were on their way to do the practical, familiar task of preparing the body for burial. They would have stood outside the tomb, grief stricken and despairing, just as Omar and his wife did so, and just as countless others before and since have done so. And yet, little did they know, as we do now, that what greeted them at the tomb would arguably be the single most significant event in human history. 'He is not here; he is risen!'

The resurrection of Jesus Christ offers us all a great hope. But this is not a 'touch-wood', 'fingers-crossed' hope, but one based on this single event in history, testified by over 500 people that he appeared to over that time, as well as the countless Christians who experience his life-changing, comforting presence every day. If Jesus in his humanity really did pass through death and came alive again, then death has indeed 'lost its sting' and Christ is able to carry us through when our time comes. This gives me great hope for Omar and his wife and all who are standing outside various tombs in their lives, whatever they might be. I trust that you too will know this great hope that the risen Christ brings to us all over this Easter season.

Why choose Therapeutic Yoga?

Also known as 'Physio-led Yoga', this fusion of yoga and physiotherapy is therapy for mind and body, explains Bradley Stoke's Chartered Physiotherapist and Yoga Instructor, Louise Dodds.

All yoga is therapeutic, but when the class is led by a physiotherapist it can help you address specific conditions including low back pain, stiffness and pain in your joints, headaches, anxiety and more. You are being guided by someone with a medical background who understands how your body works.

The one-to-one session before you attend your first class also means the therapist can find out more about you. This ensures the yoga poses in class are modified to best suit you and your medical history.

Therapeutic Yoga is about learning how your particular body moves, challenging it safely and knowing that you are in control. Being looked after by a physio will reassure you that you are doing the best thing for your body.


There can be some great "side effects" too, which can be a surprise for those who start practising yoga for strength and flexibility: yoga has been shown to help with anxiety, sleep problems, reduction in blood pressure and improvement in digestion.

Classes generally start with some gentle stretching movements, then progress to specific warm up movements for the part of the body we are concentrating on. We move on to modified positions of a full yoga pose. The poses become more challenging as we progress, but you only do as much as you feel able.

The yoga pose shown in the photo below releases tension in the lower back. From a physiotherapy view point the hamstrings need to lengthen to allow this release to happen.



Padanguthasana can be performed lying down and the use of a belt or strap helps with any lack of flexibility. Lying also takes away the need to balance, as you might in standing, and allows the mid back muscles to release helping stretch through the spine.



Yoga should be available to everyone. Finding the class that is right for you can take some time. Here at Bradley Stoke Physio & Health we aim to help anyone who wishes to progress in yoga. We run Chair-based Yoga courses, Therapeutic Yoga courses and 1:1 Yoga sessions.

Local air ambulance sees increase in demand with 2019 its busiest year to date

Great Western Air Ambulance Charity (GWAAC) have announced that 2019 was their busiest year to date, with their Critical Care Team receiving over 2,000 call-outs to incidents across the region. In 2019, they received 637 call outs in Bristol alone, an 8% increase on 2018's figures in this area

The air ambulance and critical care service. which is charity funded, provides emergency medical care to the most seriously ill or injured across Bristol, Bath and North East Somerset, North Somerset, Gloucestershire and South Gloucestershire.



GWAAC's Critical Care Team consists of highly skilled Critical Care Doctors and Specialist Paramedics, who bring the skills of an emergency hospital department to the scene of an incident. They have the ability to carry out life-saving interventions, such as blood transfusions or emergency anesthesia to the patient, where it's needed the most.

Last year saw an almost 6% increase on the total number of call-outs from 2018, with the crew attending over 5 incidents a day on average. Cardiac arrests continue to be the most common incident that the team are called to, making up over a third of the missions, with road traffic collisions the second highest.

This increasing demand on the service means the charity needs to raise over £4 million a year to remain operational, yet they receive no day to day funding from the Government or National Lottery, relying on the generosity and support from its local communities.

A former patient of the charity's services, Chris Hickey, said: "GWAAC saved my life! I had a sudden cardiac arrest and without the intervention of the air ambulance. I wouldn't be here today. You just never know when you might need the service and it can only keep going if it has the help of the whole community. Please give whatever you can so that someone else has the opportunity to have their life saved."

101 Things to Do

before your leave Bailey's Court Primary School!

This term at Bailey's Court Primary School, we have launched an exciting new project. We are calling it '101 things to do before you leave Bailey's Court Primary School'. Our idea was inspired by conversations we've had in school and an initiative that we've borrowed from the National Trust! As we all know, children benefit hugely from playing together with friends and family, experiencing new things, building relationships with nature, being challenged physically and having fun! None of these ideas are new but our project will offer a series of challenges for all of our children from Reception to Year 6 that will build, amongst other things, resilience, a sense of responsibility and some fabulous memories.

At the end of each year, the children can earn a special award building towards a special presentation at the end of Y6.

Following up from the Bottle Rocket Event, we also held a Science and Engineering Day across the school. A local engineer came to talk to the children about the importance of engineering, and was particularly keen to inspire and motivate girls to be engineers. We then spent the day designing and making a variety of objects and artefacts, including bridges, towers and boats. These were then scientifically tested, exploring aspects of forces.

The children had great fun and learnt a great deal. We hope this will be part of inspiring children to see themselves as scientists and engineers in the making.





Frampton Cotterell Computer Group Celebrating 20 years

Twenty years ago, Frampton Cotterell Parish Council decided to set up a computer group in the newly opened Brockeridge Centre with the primary aim of helping older people come to grips with home computers. At that time, less than 40% of UK households had a computer at home and even fewer had an Internet connection. Many people. particularly of an older generation, had never used a computer but were interested in finding out how to use one and in discovering the benefits they might offer in their daily life.

A group of volunteers came together and started offering classes to help people who wanted to learn about using a home computer. In 2008, the group became independent of the Parish Council while still occupying a room at the Brockeridge Centre and maintaining a close working relationship with them.

Keith Powell who has been chairman of the group since it became independent said. "When we started, few people would have imagined we'd still be going 20 years later. We've seen many changes over the years, with fewer people now being completely new to computers and more wanting help with specific questions. Technology has also changed significantly with the introduction of tablets and smartphones as well as major changes to software such as Windows and MS Office. Our team of volunteers has adapted to these changes and we are still assisting people with a wide range of issues. These include: using the internet safely and securely, dealing with digital photographs. keeping track of finances using spreadsheets. creating and managing email accounts and taking advantage of cloud computing services.






