New Mayor, Election of Standing Committee Chairs and Update on Grant Funding and Youth Work at the Bradley Stoke Town Council

Cllr Tony Griffiths, New Mayor for Bradley Stoke:

"I am looking forward to my year in office and will continue to act and help the constituents of Bradley Stoke, acting as your Mayor. I have lived in Bradley Stoke for 13 years and have served on the



Town Council for the last 9 years, being elected in May 2011, re-elected in May 2015 and with an increased majority in May 2019.

This year is going to be a tough year where difficult decisions are being made, we already have cancelled some projects where in these unprecedented times Covid-19 has played a significant part in all our lives, locally, nationally and internationally. I am sure the effects of this global pandemic have been intense which has affected our emotions by knowing a friend or relative has been affected.

As a council we have had to cancel many engagements which has had an affect on our town. The next engagement will be the Firework Display in November which this year will be pet friendly, having its usual fantastic free display without the loud bangs. It may be possible to hold an event in the Spring and I would like suggestions from you as to whatever type of event you would like to see, maybe a return to Proms on the Green?

The Mayor's Charities this year will be to continue to support the Great Western Air Ambulance which cost £3,000,000 per year to run, this equates to £8,219 per day with no other funding other than charitable donations. Secondly, I would like to support Next Link a Domestic Abuse Charity close to my family's heart.

Finally, I wish to support and provide local initiatives and organisations to which you may call on me to attend any function you plan to. I am here to serve you for that purpose. Please 'Stay Safe' hoping that you may enjoy the summer and year ahead."

Bradley Stoke Town Council has elected Councillor Terri Cullen, Councillor Roger Avenin and Councillor Ben Randles as its Standing Committee Chairs for the civic year 2020-21.

The Council, through its standing committee, has decided to award Three Brooks Nature Conservation Group an amount of £2,000 as part of the Service Level Agreement and to allow them to keep £275 from previous year's funding. The council also allowed a grant aid of £500 towards the Bradley Stoke Community Singers.

The Council's Youth work will be resumed post lockdown as per guidelines of National Youth Agency and other youth work support services. The virtual youth work sessions delivered by the Council's youth worker has been generally welcomed by young people and parents. Since lockdown regulations concerning sporting activities has been eased off recently, the Council's Skatepark has been reopened with social-distancing measures in place. The Council requested all skatepark users to comply with the safety protocols.

Cllr Tom Aditya, who is also Council's Press Spokesperson commented the need to expedite construction of the proposed 'Multi-Use Games Area' (illustration below) at the Jubilee Green by extending existing hardcourts and by incorporating basketball playing facilities, which will be considered by the Council after obtaining detailed quotes. The Council is also considering development of the Jubilee Green Fitness Area, which will be a great feature for Bradley Stoke.



Three Brooks Nature Conservation Group

We've always known what an inspiring place our Nature Reserve is, we're just sorry it took a lockdown for it to be appreciated by evervone!



At 46ha it's the largest local nature reserve in South Gloucestershire and with over 22,000 residents is surrounded by one of the largest housing estates in Europe. Whether your thing is just feeling the sun warming your face, cool ancient woodlands, open meadows, flowers, orchards, bug hunting, pond dipping, orienteering, butterfly or bird watching or just chilling by the water we have it all and all right on your doorstep.

Although we have had our fair share of cancellations - work days, birthday cakes, Earth Hour and walks to name a few - we have managed to get some things done. Some of the gates have either been removed or have been propped open, some paths were widened and bridges were cleared of encroaching vegetation. And although a group is required for a newt survey (traipsing around ponds in the dark on your own is not recommended!) it is easy to monitor our burgeoning slowworm population on your own. Our refugia have also given us an unexpected bonus as they are often used by small mammals and we have at times found up to 3 field voles and a shrew all huddled together beneath one of them, suggesting that we have a much higher population than we previously thought. Sponsored by SGC, eight leaves from each of our apple trees have been sent off for analysis to have their provenance determined and we hope to soon be able to replace like for like some of the lost trees in the Community Orchard. A big Thank You too, to Michael Hunt who nipped out one morning to dig over Colin's Allotment just in time for what would have been his birthday.

We aren't the only ones who have been busy on the reserve, David Neale spotted Red Kites (although I can't print what was said when he wasn't able to get a photo!) and also a Ring Necked



Parakeet was seen although we've yet to find out if this is an escapee or a wild one. And our lakes duckling population has increased by 1 - a couple rescued an 'abandoned' duckling from some overly attentive cats but as it was almost fully grown I took it down to the lake in the hope that our only resident mum (Matilda) will add him to her small family. If you see her with 3 ducklings you'll know she did.



We've also had reports of pollution in the water, caused we think by heavy rain washing oil from the roads into the storm drains. Please do be aware that what goes down the street drains ends up in our brooks.

During lockdown the woodland school area was trashed and we've also had a surprisingly large number of reports of fires and BBQ's (neither of which are ever allowed on the reserve without prior permission) the seating area in Savages Wood is designed as an Outdoor Classroom not a campfire pit. Several areas have been turned into 'outdoor pubs' (notably the 'scrape' on the tump that was cordoned off for the Grizzled Skipper butterfly). Thank you to our army of unsung hero's who clean up after them but we'd prefer that if you're going to use the reserve for drinking alcohol you didn't leave behind broken bottles and empty cans (both are dangerous to people and animals) and if you're going to pee in a public place please try and be discreet, as there are some photo's I really don't want on my computer!

For anyone still searching for orienteering post number 9, my apologies, it's on my driveway

awaiting repair, shortly I think to be followed by number 4 (thank you Richard). If you know of any others that are in need of attention please do let us know either via email: report-it@three-brooks.info or on our Facebook page.



Even though we are unsure how many walks we will be able to run this year we are very grateful to Bradley Stoke Town Council for again granting us £2000 for our SLA (Service Level Agreement). The reserve is 'owned' by SGC but it is BSTC who give us the grant. Before the lockdown Green Gym had also applied for a British Science Week grant to install a permanent Star Gazing bed with a compass and planisphere but as that grant has now been closed. I personally am hoping that any under spend we have this year can be used for this project.

Our Lake: If you've spotted something that looks like a Cormorant or a Shaq at the lake you could be right, although they are both usually sea birds no one seems to have told them! The water level at the moment is very variable but until it is de-silted there is not much we can do about it. As you may know SGC has agreed to cover the cost of desilting the lake this winter and there will be a small pot of money left over for other 'improvements' and an additional grant application has also been made to improve the paths.

Local architectural designer Jake Richardson has generously drawn us some plans for a very posh bird hide and I would like to see more educational boards and bird / bat boxes, a boardwalk enclosing a shallow 'pond dipping area' along with a hand operated water wheel and a solar fountain. Maybe I should find out just how 'small' the pot is before I add any more suggestions!

Green Gym started up again at the end of June with a proposed 'away day' at the Viaduct Exotic Animal Sanctuary to sort out their gardens. After that, with a few tweaks, careful choosing of tasks and possibly staggered start times we are confident that we can again safely run.

Bradley Stoke Radio 103.5fm closed its studio doors, quite suddenly towards the end of March 2020, as the country went into lockdown. The closure, at that time, was not anticipated to be for this length of time and no one really imagined the speed and the effect that Covid-19 and the ongoing situation would have.

However, it is testament to the volunteers that we have continued to broadcast our programmes through remote access. The technical team stepped in and produced instructions and advice to those that needed it and the resilience and commitment of the presenters and admin support has shone through and our membership has grown as people have joined us to make radio programmes from home, for our community.

While our pre-booked summer events have all been cancelled, we worked with the Carnival committee to have VE day at home on the radio - 5 hours of themed broadcasting was produced with messages of hope from Metro Mayor Tim Bowles, Cllr Toby Savage, Cllr Toni Scott and Cllr. Franklin Owusu-Antwi. All broadcast on May 8th on 103.4fm - smart speaker - online

Our members took part in a national social media campaign #radiofromhome

We had an interview with MP Jack Lopresti early on in the lockdown phase 1 and continue to invite him for interviews and comments.

We shared events with community radio stations across Bristol and BBC Radio Bristol - The grand Iftar celebrating across our communities was broadcast on 23rd Mav.

We have worked with local churches and continue to broadcast a regular Sunday service from Bradley Stoke Evangelical Church or St Michaels, Stoke Gifford giving residents the opportunity to listen to a local church service from home.

And we continue to broadcast current Public Health England advice and Government announcements relating to Covid-19 and locally where people can get help and advice including Southern Brooks for Patchway, Face for Filton and Stokes Covid 19 for Bradley Stoke and surrounding areas.

Our programme output has developed, including new local history, community trivia quiz, specialist music programming, interviews and more, as we continue to support our local communities and businesses with updates and relevant news.

While it looks like public events and gatherings are a way off yet, you can join with local people, sharing local voices and more on 103.4fm, online or smart speaker asking to play Bradley Stoke Radio. from Almondsbury to Filton, Patchway to Frampton Cottrell and of course, across all the Stokes. Almondsbury Charity

(REGISTERED CHARITY No. 202263)

Almondsbury Charity is a charity which provides help to people and organisations within the local area. The origin dates back to medieval times when various benefactors made bequests for the benefit of the poor and needy and for the repair and maintenance of the churches within the parish. In succeeding years, with the agreement of the Charity Commission changes have been made to enable the trustees to meet requests which are appropriate to the needs of modern society.

To benefit from the charity, individuals and organisations must reside or be located within the boundaries of the parish of Almondsbury that existed in 1881. Today this includes Almondsbury. Patchway (including Charlton Hayes), Pilning, Easter Compton and Bradley Stoke, north of Tesco.

The Charity's income is derived from a capital sum which is professionally managed and is paid

annually. The net income is divided between the two funds: 60% is used for Education and Relief and 40% for the Upkeep of the local Churches. The Charity is managed by 12 trustees who are representative of the local community.

The Education and Relief Fund is available to help individuals who are in need because of illness or financial hardship. In particular the trustees are always pleased to receive requests from the elderly.

The trustees can also provide support for those, under the age of 30, looking to further their education, in particular those attending establishments of higher education and/or studying music or other arts or hoping to travel as part of their studies. The Ecclesiastical Fund is used for the repair and maintenance of the churches and to further the work of Church of England in the area of benefit.



Hello everyone, I hope you have all been keeping safe and well in this very different time! Like so many of us my Holistic Health Clinic in Little Stoke had to close on 23rd March and so too did the classroom. REIKI

Introduction to Reiki - free Monday 3-4pm

Reiki 1 - £70 over 2 sessions (same day over 2 weeks) Mondays 7-9pm or Fridays 2-4pm

Reiki 2 - £90 over 2 session (same day over 2 weeks) Tuesdays 2-4pm or Wednesdays 6-8pm I will need to see a copy of your Reiki 1 certificate if you haven't previously completed it with me

Reiki Master - £225 over 2 sessions (same day over 2 weeks) Tuesdays 7-9pm or Wednesdays 2-4pm

I will need to see a copy of your Reiki 2 certificate if you haven't previously completed it with me and you will need to be a Reiki practitioner, we will need to discuss whether you are ready to go to this level, prior to booking.

There will be a third session for your attunement for each of the above levels on a 1-2-1 basis, which will be put in the diary after the teaching is completed.

Ongoing "circle sessions" will also be set up after each course.

AROMATHERAPY



Since 23 March when all schools in the UK were closed due to the Covid 19 panademic. life has still been very busy at Bradley Stoke Community School.

As part of the Olympus Academy Trust, BSCS was chosen as the hub school that would remain open during this period for the students and staff of all schools in the Trust area, to enable their parent/ carers as keyworkers to remain working

Every week, including half term and the Easter holidays, staff from across the Trust have welcomed over 60 students in every week to continue their studies, have a safe place to play and learn, not to mention a hot meal at lunchtime. During this time staff very quickly got to grips with the various online teaching methods that were in place and home working was enabled immediately for all students via Google classroom. Students with little or no access to IT were assisted with the provision of laptops and wifi connections to enable everyone to continue with their studies as quickly as possible. Staff meetings were held via Zoom, Google and Skype!

The Olympus Trust created a Transition Pack for each of the 180 students due to start at BSCS in September 2020 and these were hand delivered by staff. It was great for the staff to make contact with the students and families (via social distancing of course) and to ensure they knew they were not forgotten! The packs included a paperback reading book for all students, a learning pack and some stationery. BSCS also held a virtual online Transition parent and student evening on 22 June. All very different to the events that are held at this time of year every year for new students!

During this period BSCS also delivered Food and Care packages to families in need within the Bradley Stoke area nearly every week. A huge thanks to the kind contributions from staff, families and businesses in the area which has enabled this to happen. This is continuing so please keep your donations coming in to BSCS Reception area.

After lots of careful preparation and planning, the Primary Phase opened to Reception and Year 1 students on 2nd June. Then on Monday 15th June, again after a huge amount of work by our fantastic premises team, we welcomed back Year 10 and

Year 12 students. Year 10 students are in one day a week and Year 12 students are back for timetabled subject lessons. It has been great seeing the students again and the school starting to feel truly like a "real" school again.

Our Year 11 students missed out on a lot of the normal end of school traditions, but staff have worked hard to ensure they have done all they can to celebrate their time at school. Y11 Prom has

a provisional revised date and another date later in the year in case the first doesn't take place! They are holding a Year 11 Leavers Awards assembly online on the afternoon of 1 July and students will be receiving a hand delivered goody bag in the days running up to it - or even on the morning if time allows. There is also the bi-annual musical extravaganza of our 'Live Lounge' event that will be performed online at 7pm on the 16th July with donations going towards our Food Bank charity.

All in all, it's been a busy few months for us and a really steep learning curve. BSCS would like to thank all the staff, parents and families for all their support over this period – the community supporting one another has really shone through and made what has been an incredibly challenging period in our children's lives at least be manageable and enabled learning and schooling in a very different form to continue. We look forward to starting the new academic year in September with all of our students back in school, although we do not know if that will be full time or part time as the government are due to publish their latest guidelines this week. We will be updating parents as soon as possible. In the meantime, keep well and have a great summer from all at BSCS to all of our children, students and families.

Vicky continued: "We hope to better meet the needs of local working families and their children with our new plans. The extended opening hours will benefit working parents, as will the year-round provision.


