St Michael's Church, Stoke Gifford, teamed up with Sainsbury's East Filton, to put on a drive-in church service Over 100 cars were in attendance, with an estimated total of around 300 people.

Since lock down began, faith leaders across the country have been looking at inventive ways to continue patterns of worship, when meeting together hasn't been possible. Although restrictions have now eased slightly, singing is still not permitted indoors. With that in mind, and spurred on by Newquav's recent Drive in Church. St Michael's decided to make corporate worship possible, from a car park.

Revd Tom Benyon, one of the clergy team at St Michael's says, 'Like so many churches across the country we've been producing stacks of online services over lockdown, but we've really missed meeting and worshipping together as a church family. So we were delighted to be able to hold a drive-in service. It was a really vibrant, joyful event - full of laughter and hope. We got together safely, sang some songs, heard about the good news of Jesus and had fun along the way and all from the comfort of our cars!'

Sainsbury's at East Filton, which falls within the Stoke Gifford parish boundaries, has a large car park and the team at St Michael's thought it seemed like a fantastic place to put on their service. The store were very helpful and made the team feel really welcome.

Many who attended commented on how enjoyable the event was and how moving it was to worship alongside others after so

News from Bradley Stoke Library

Limited library services now available

From 6 July we introduced limited services by appointment only in line with latest public health advice. This means visiting the library in the way we were all used to before lockdown, for the moment, is not possible. In line with government regulations, from Saturday 8 August face coverings must be worn in the library, unless a person is exempt.

Our libraries look and feel guite different as we are able to offer only limited services by booking in advance. All of our libraries have hand sanitiser at the entrances and floor markings are in place so people can follow the direction of travel required.

These changes have been made to allow social distancing in line with current Government guidance and keep users and staff safe.

You must not come to an appointment if you or anyone you live with have any symptoms of COVID-19 or you have been instructed to selfisolate by NHS test and trace Now COVID-19 lockdown restrictions have eased, our libraries have introduced pre-bookable services to borrow books, DVDs and audiobooks and access a computer and use the Wi-Fi. This is so you can access them in a safe and controlled way. It does mean visiting the library in the way we were all used to before lockdown, for the moment, is not possible.

Book for 1 hour free use of a computer or our Wi-Fi using your own device

Our free online library is still open 24/7

eBooks, eAudiobooks, eComics, digital magazines and newspapers continue to be available for library members to download anytime - www.southglos.gov.uk/eresources has all the details.

It now also includes Who Else Writes Like?. and for children, Who Next? where you can find authors who write in a similar way to those you have already enjoyed reading. Simply log in with your library card number and select South Gloucestershire.



Local scout leader answers the call during **COVID 19 lockdown**

We all know how our front line workers are continuing to work through the virus lockdown in the Country but what isn't as well known is the army of sewers that are helping supply the essential workers with face masks and scrub bags to make their lives a little easier.

After an appeal from the NHS for scrubs bags, to put their dirty uniforms in to bring home and wash. Penny Hallett-Allen, a lady from Stoke Gifford and part of St Michael's Church agreed to co-ordinate the deliveries. That's when local scout leader Ali Emsley rose to the challenge and made well over 200 bags with help from her daughter Pip, some personalised. covering two Doctor's surgeries, the Community dentist, several ICU nurses and friends. Once Southmead Hospital had enough, further bags went to care homes in the area.

One of the recipients an ICU nurse was so pleased at all the time and effort Ali had taken to make her 4 personalised scrubs bags saying "Thank you so much Ali, the bags are fabulous the last thing I feel like doing when I get home from a 12 hour shift having worn all the PPE is sort through my laundry so the bags are great".

Once enough bags had been made instead of sitting back and admiring her work Ali moved on to face masks. Then again covering a doctor's surgery, various colleagues and people in Stoke Gifford. This was her way of helping COVID pandemic by supporting the local community.

Ali said "My poor sewing machine has had to go in for a service as it has not been used this much for a long time, in order for the onslaught of face masks. I am only too thankful that my skill set has been put to good use"

This amazing amount of sewing is all on top of her full time job and the volunteer work she does.

Popular disability charity, Paul's Place, makes plans to reopen after lockdown.

The popular South Gloucestershire disability charity, Paul's Place, is planning to reopen after the lockdown.

Paul's Place is a charity that enhances life for physically disabled adults, through social activities that connect people, reduce isolation, improve health and wellbeing and give people the opportunity to develop new skills, enjoy new experience and live life to the full. In March, due to the coronavirus crisis, the charity was forced to close its day facility in response to government quidelines and the lockdown situation.

Since closing the day facility in Coalpit Heath, Paul's Place has continued to support those physically disabled people who rely on them by setting up the 'Paul's Place at Home' Project. Staff and volunteers have kept in regular contact with people through telephone calls and daily online meetings that people take part in from their own homes. CEO Daniel Cheesman said, "Overnight we were forced to embrace technology and offer Paul's Place online to people. I am really proud that we have continued to stay in touch with people and we now have a new and much-loved service in 'Paul's Place at Home'."

Daniel continued to explain the impact that coronavirus has had on disabled people, "The reality is that for many physically disabled people the impact of lockdown has been life changing. People are naturally worried about their physical health, but it is the impact that we have seen on people's mental health that has been the most worrying. 'Paul's Place at Home', has meant that people have stayed connected with others and it has become a real lifeline for people."

With the lockdown restrictions changing, Paul's Place is planning to reopen face to face projects. Staff have already started to make home visits to people and small groups of people are meeting, socially distanced in community spaces. Daniel explained the complications of reopening the day facility. "Reopening the day facility is a huge responsibility and with it comes a mixed set of emotions. We are excited to be opening again so that we can see people and offer our much-loved





service. Safety is the number one priority and when we reopen things will look a little different. Like all businesses we are complying with the social distancing requirements and have put in place things to help us manage this. We are working closely with our Members (the people who use Paul's Place) to ensure that with any changes, we keep the essence of Paul's Place."

It is the essence of Paul's Place that has proved the longevity of the charity, as this year Paul's Place is celebrating its 25th year. The charity had several fundraising events planned throughout 2020, to help celebrate and bring in much needed charitable funds to the charity. As well as adapting the services that the charity offers, Paul's Place has also adapted its fundraising plans and has held many virtual fundraising events in the last four months including a fortnightly online quiz and a virtual cream tea. 
club with an excellent base for key events throughout the season and a place for all teams and parents to socialise after games.


