



Commemorating an Historic Moment in Time at Patchway Community School

Little Stoke Gifford Matters was pleased to hear from Miss Haines, Head of Humanities at Patchway Community School, sharing the story of their commemoration of King Charles III's Coronation by way of planting a time capsule and tree.

Together with the PCS team and the year 7s, a small ceremony was arranged to mark the coronation. The pupils received a lesson educating them about the history

of coronations, how they have been celebrated over time and why they're considered a significant moment in history – one we are all living through right now! The pupils then wrote letters to the future, recounting experiences of what it is like to live in 2023, significant events etc as well as predictions and hopes for what life might be like in the future. Some students also added drawings to the capsule – flags, crowns and Victoria sponges aplenty!

Following the expressed wishes of King Charles III, a tree was also chosen to be planted to mark the occasion. We chose an apple tree for its beautiful blossoms, role in supporting pollinators and the opportunity to provide fresh fruit (it has been planted only a short walk from our Home Tech rooms). It was wonderful to read how many students had included climate change and sustainability within their letters; they've learnt about this topic this year and showed a real understanding of how the planting of the tree linked to ideas of sustainability and caring for our environment.

The pupils themselves were very hands on! We had many volunteering to dig the holes with a shovel, some happily removing the dirt with their hands and getting involved with planting the tree. The tree was planted within our nature reserve, this area is going to be protected whilst our new school is being built, meaning our time capsule will not be disturbed until we choose to do so long into the future.













Use your savings as a force for good

- Tackle climate change by funding the delivery of pioneering clean energy projects such as rooftop solar panels on community
- Support local community with cheaper energy bills for host buildings, and raising community benefit funds for local initiatives
- Democratise energy ownership, allowing communities and individuals to feel the benefit of renewable energy generation
- Earn a potential financial return, with a projected 5% in this share offer

BEC's business model of raising funds has proved very successful so far. Since it was set up in 2011, the co-op has raised over £15 million, and developed over 10MWp of solar and battery assets, enough to power roughly 3,250 homes. The organisation is an important contributor of renewable energy in the South West, generating roughly the equivalent of 30% of Bristol's solar energy.



It's not only BEC's members that gain from a return on investment. Over the past 10 vears, the cooperative has channelled over £350,000 of community benefit payments into local sustainability initiatives, such as community gardens, education and biodiversity programmes. Also, community spaces such as Easton Community Centre and Knowle West Media Centre have benefitted from cheaper energy rates thanks to the solar installations by BEC, meaning they have more funds to spend on their vital services. In December 2022 BEC completed a 1MW rooftop PV install at the second Bottleyard Film studios (TBY2). This is by far its largest rooftop scheme to date, and BEC believes it's the largest community rooftop solar array in the UK.

The cooperative currently has 1,500 members. and is looking to grow and diversify its membership to help create a just energy transition.

Anyone can invest in BEC's withdrawable shares, from as little as £100. Investors are projected to receive a 5% annual return. The share offer is open until 17th July 2023. For more information please see: https://bristolenergy.coop/share-offer-2023/

Meet your PCC – Mark Shelford

Avon & Somerset Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC). Mark Shelford was elected as Conservative PCC in 2021.

I would like to start with a huge thank you to all the police officers who ensured that The King's Coronation Bank Holiday weekend was enjoyed safely by all across Avon and Somerset, as well as in the capital.

There was also so much good work happening as part of the Big Help Out Coronation celebration that it would be remiss of me not to acknowledge all the community spirit and dedicated citizens across our area who volunteer their time all year round to create safer and better neighbourhoods for evervone.

On that note, I am pleased to inform you all that the Commissioner's Crime Prevention Fund grant has officially opened. This grant, set up by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner (OPCC) in partnership with Somerset Community Foundation and Quartet Community Foundation, aims to reduce crime and anti-social behaviour through community projects and activities across the region.

I would like to congratulate and thank all the local community groups and organisations previously awarded this grant. They have delivered some fantastic crime-reducing initiatives and activities.

I implore local organisations and community groups to apply for this worthwhile funding to reduce antisocial behaviour and make our communities safe.

In our most recent Performance and Accountability Board (PAB), the Chief Constable (CC) and I discussed the quarterly performance report, which looks at Avon and Somerset Police's (ASP) performance against the national policing priorities and ASP's Police and Crime Plan.

The data from the quarterly performance report provided an opportunity to reflect on the police's current performance and ask questions regarding what steps are being taken to make necessary improvements for our communities.

Our next PAB will take place on 14 June at 10:30 am and be streamed live on our Facebook page



May 15th marked the start of Operation Sceptre, a national initiative to combat knife crime. This targeted initiative aims to reduce the prevalence of knife-related violence, increase public safety, and engage communities in the fight against this issue.

Proactively tackling knife crime is central to my Police and Crime Plan. I encourage people to safely discard any weapons or knives they may carry in the weapons surrender bins installed by Avon and Somerset Police.

Last month, new surrender bins were installed in areas where we know they are needed to offer people a safe and anonymous way of getting rid of a weapon. If you know someone who carries a weapon, we ask you to encourage them to surrender it. Find your nearest weapon surrender bin on the ASP website under Crime Prevention Advice.

ASP and its partners already carry out a large range of activities to raise awareness of and combat knife crime, and the work of the Violence Reduction Units (VRUs) is at the heart of this. The Police work closely with the VRUs and help to deliver talks to young people in primary and secondary schools, running Blunt Truth workshops in partnership with the NHS and hosting pop-up information stands around various local areas.

While we have seen a reduction in street-based knife crime across Avon and Somerset, more still needs to be done to ensure people feel safe in their communities. Knife crime ruins lives. Let's raise awareness, educate, and stand against knife crime.

Pioneering Clinic for Recurrent Miscarriage

With around 15% of women experiencing miscarriage at least once in their lives and one in a hundred suffering recurrent miscarriage, the opening of a pioneering clinic locally offering a unique combination of treatments not previously available in the region will give new hope to those affected.

Fertility expert and gynaecologist Hajeb Kamali (pictured) said: "All other considerations aside, miscarriage and particularly recurrent miscarriage is associated with an increased risk of developing depression, anxiety and even PTSDS."

In the UK the definition of recurrent miscarriage is three or more miscarriages, whereas in the US and across Europe the threshold is two miscarriages, which means that investigations start at a later point in this country.



An important expert review of miscarriages globally, published recently in the Lancet, recommends that a new model of care should be adopted around miscarriage care and prevention, but - largely due to resource restrictions - the NHS's approach means currently there is no referral for specialist care until after a third miscarriage, and even after a referral there can often be a long wait to be seen by a specialist consultant. In around half of cases, investigations may reveal a cause which could include a blood clotting disorder, hormonal disfunction such as thyroid problems, polycystic ovarian syndrome, uterine problems such as fibroids or scar tissue in the womb.

Hajeb Kamali said: "There are often lifestyle factors that can be optimised to improve the chances of a successful pregnancy in the future even following a first miscarriage. This means anyone who has experienced miscarriage, whether it be a first or more than one, could benefit from a review because this could provide an insight into their personal or medical history that may alter and reduce their risk of losing a future pregnancy.

In addition some couples may simply want reassurance and support in moving forward with their attempts to build a family."

Mr Kamali, who has been lead consultant at North Bristol Trust for their recurrent miscarriage service, has joined Bristol Centre for Reproductive Medicine (BCRM) at Aztec West, where he is launching a brand new private clinic for recurrent miscarriage which will provide investigations, tests and treatments


Diagnostic options at BCRM's new clinic include hysteroscopy and a 3D scanner as well as advanced male investigations such as sperm DNA fragmentation.

Mr Kamali said: "The services we offer are cutting edge and comprehensive and simply not available on the NHS, nor privately elsewhere in the region. What we're launching is a genuinely stand-out clinic, the only one in the region to offer a more advanced range of investigations and a dedicated bespoke service. What's more, as part of the wider BCRM fertility service, we are able to offer our patients more advanced assisted conception treatments options where appropriate such as preimplantation genetic screening (PGS), a recognised treatment for recurrent miscarriage."

Hajeb Kamali concluded: "We are also actively involved in ongoing research into miscarriage, and there is ongoing and fascinating work being done in this area, such as research into the role of the maternal immune response in miscarriage."





the old tree stakes and coppicing the woodland to allow the wildflowers to grow, as well as building a new bog garden, which we have finished just in time for spring. Volunteers have been learning many new skills including tree planting and tree maintenance. As project leaders we greatly appreciate the help UWE and UoB student volunteers provide every workday, without them we wouldn't be able to complete the work we set out at the beginning of each academic year. So far there are close to 50 student volunteers who have come at different workdays to help, it's a big number and shows Conservation Volunteering is of great interest to them, we look forward to welcoming other student volunteers and encourage anyone with an interest to become a conservation volunteer."

On behalf of the community representatives on the Splatts Abbey Wood committee, (Andy Ward, Jenny James, David Bell, Isabelle Plummer) - Fred Hillberg said - "I remember Splatts Abbey Wood when you had to fight your way from one end to the other and was a bit of an adventure playground for the little gang I was in with my schoolmates. There was also an adjoining Woodland which later disappeared. It was therefore of great interest to me when, about twenty years ago, I read that South Gloucestershire Council were looking for volunteers to help manage and renovate and preserve this Ancient Woodland for the benefit of the community. The Woodland is now owned by the MOD and leased to South Glos Council. It was hard work initially for the local volunteers, which included staff from the MOD, to open up the woodland by Coppicing and establishing pathways. Progress was very slow for a number of years, until we were joined by volunteers from the UWE, and this made a tremendous difference. Projects were achieved in months which previously had taken years, and thankfully that partnership continues to flourish today, giving the local community a facility of flora and fauna that we can all enjoy and protect for the future."

How To Protect Your Home From Property Fraud

Rachel Dickinson, solicitor at AMD Solicitors, discusses how to protect your home from property fraud.

One of the issues which is currently in the media is the risk of property fraud whereby individuals use various means to obtain money or property using properties at risk. This is often to benefit other criminal activity.

What properties are at high risk?

- Empty properties
- Tenanted properties
- Properties which could become empty
- Properties not subject to a mortgage
- Unregistered properties
- Properties which are not occupied all the time

How can you protect your home?

- Register your unregistered property
- Add a Restriction to your property which sets out certain requirements which need to be met before registration of a transaction takes place.
- Keeping your contact details up to date with the land registry (free service – complete and send COG1 form to the Land Registry)
- Use the New Property Alert Service to notify you of any applications that have been made against your property. (free service – www.gov. uk/property-alert)

There are benefits associated with all these alternatives but there are also some pitfalls. If you would like advice on which option fits your circumstances or assistance with completing the necessary forms please contact us.

Property Alert

Using the Property Alert service is very simple.

- · Go to the website address above
- Complete your details including your email address and a safe password and register
- Add the property(ies) you wish to monitor (maximum 10)
- Monitor your emails
- · Keep your details up to date





service notifies you if anyone makes an application to register something against the title. It relies on you to check that the transaction is legitimate. If it is not you can then contact the Land Registry fraud line on 0300 006 7030 or at reportafraud@ landregistry.gov.uk . It does not prevent transactions being registered but it enables you to be warned and take action.

If you find you are notified and do not know what to do next, first contact the Land Registry.




