



The role of Pilates and Posture

"Never slouch as doing so compresses the lungs, overcrowds other vital organs, rounds the back, and throws you off balance." (Joseph Pilates)

Different postural types place strain and load on different joints, ligaments and muscles in the body, which in time cause stiffness and sensitivity in the tissues.

This results in weakness in the affected muscle groups, as the body adopts this new 'normal' posture. The body then becomes more susceptible to injury, even at low load and range of movement.



Sound Meditation with Craia Rogerson from Soundworks

I founded Soundworks, my sound therapy practice, four years ago with a simple aim: to help others through sound. My main offerings include 1:1 sessions and group sound meditations - also known as sound baths. Using a range of sound tools and instruments, we create true moments of rest.

In a session, you'll experience anything from the grounding beats of worldly percussion, to the resonant frequencies of singing bowls, gongs, and a few other sonic treats. We use their audible qualities to tap into a phenomenon called brainwave entrainment - this allows us to access lower brainwave states. We also use their mechanical vibration that signals our parasympathetic system - our natural "rest and restore" mode. So it's not just what we hear. but also what we feel. These long, sustaining tones can carry us into a still, meditative state - a quiet place that many of us rarely get to visit.

When was the last time you truly took a moment for yourself?

Beautiful things happen when we really stop, and, when we add the aid of sound to that, I've witnessed real shifts in people. My mission is to create regular, accessible spaces for people to rest in sound, and I'd love to let more people know about these spaces.

We gather every month on a Sunday afternoon at Turnberries Community Centre in Thornbury. It's a grounding space - and it's open to everyone. You don't need to have any meditation experience. You don't even need a yoga mat as I always bring a few spares. All you need is the willingness to show up with an open mind, and let the sound do the rest.

Later Life Planning – The Importance of Lasting Powers of Attorney

When we think about planning for the future, most of us focus on making a Will or putting money aside for retirement. But one area that is often overlooked, is what would happen if you were to lose mental capacity during your lifetime.

It might come as a surprise to many, that without the right legal arrangements in place, your closest family members, including even your spouse, would not have the legal authority to manage your property and finances or make decisions about your health and welfare if you could no longer do so yourself.

A Lasting Power of Attorney (LPA) is a legal document that gives you the ability to appoint someone you trust to act on your behalf should you lose capacity, known as an attorney. There are two types of LPAs: one covering property and financial affairs, and the other relates to health and welfare.

A LPA for Property and Financial Affairs allows your chosen attorney(s) to handle matters such as managing your bank accounts, paying bills, collecting benefits, and dealing with your property. The health and welfare LPA enables your attorney to make decisions about your daily routine, medical care & needs, and even consenting to or refusing lifesustaining treatment. An LPA also gives your attorney(s) the authority to request medical records should this be required when considering future care provision.

Without an LPA in place, if you were to lose capacity due an illness or serious accident, the only way for someone

to legally manage your affairs would be to apply to the Court of Protection for a Deputyship Order. This can be a lengthy, costly and emotionally draining to which there is no guarantee the Court would appoint the person whom is making the application. As Deputyship Orders can take time to be issued, there is often a period where no one has authority to make any decisions.

Planning ahead by putting LPAs in place provides clarity and peace of mind for both you and your loved ones. It means your wishes are respected, and allows you to give those closest to you the legal authority to act swiftly and confidently on your behalf.

Whereas an LPA takes care of your affairs during your lifetime, it's important not to overlook the importance of a Will which takes care of your wishes after your death. A Will ensures that the right persons are appointed to deal with your estate and that your estate passes to your intended

beneficiaries. Together a Will and LPA provides vital protection to both you and your loved ones.



Local BMX Star on Track for Oz

Local BMX star, Eliza French (15), will be travelling to Brisbane, Australia next year as a member of the GB BMX team at the World Championships.

Eliza, from Bradley Stoke, has been racing since 2020 as a member of the Bristol Jets BMX club based at Patchway and in 2024 was signed by the BRE Racing Team, a national BMX team.

She progressed through the South-West Regional series and in 2024 took part in the National Series for the first time, finishing 13th. As a result, she qualified to represent GB at the World Championships in Copenhagen in late July/early August 2025 where she was just about to head off to as we went to print on this edition!



In 2025 Eliza has raced in three major race series and has made great progress, which is testament to all the hard work she puts in in training and development. Eliza participated in the 'Deep South' Winter series between October and March. This was her first time in this series, and she finished in 1st place in the Girls 15-16 age group.

Eliza then took part in the South region summer series having won the South West region three years in a row. The South region races typically have twice the number of entrants, visit a number of National-level tracks and also put her against girls who she will race in the National Series. She finished in 3rd place in the South series, against stiff competition.

In the 2025 British Cycling National Series, Eliza has made fantastic progress. At the start of the season her objective for the year was to make an 'A' final at some point, having never achieved this in 2024. Well, she made the 'A' final at the very first attempt in round 1 and kept going, making the 'A' on two further occasions across the 10 rounds! 2025 also saw her take her first moto (heat) win, a feat she then repeated two more times! She finished the National series in 7th place overall, up from 13th last year and consequently has qualified to represent GB again, this time in the 2026 BMX World Championships in Brisbane!

Eliza has also been invited to join the British Cycling BMX Talent Development Pathway Regional School of Racing.



Although the holidays are approaching, there will be no rest for Eliza as after her first World Championship in Copenhagen this month, she will still have the British Championships, South West Championships and South Championships to go. Next year's aim is to try her luck in the UCI European series!

Eliza currently trains on track three times a week with qualified coaches, goes to a local gym several times a week before school and has race meetings around the country most weekends.

Eliza is a Year 10 student at Abbeywood Community School where she is studying for her GCSEs. Amongst other subjects, she is taking a BTEC in Sport and hopes to make a career in a sports-related profession. She is also a budding musician and a talented young drummer.

News from Westminster

I'm proud to support Labour's plan to build on the legacy of Sure Start by launching up to 1,000 Best Start Family Hubs by April. The last government cut this support in South Glos, and I'm glad Labour is prioritising children and families here as a result

Thank you to everyone - around 1000 residents - who contacted me about the Terminally III Adults (End of Life) Bill. I fully respect the range of views and know this will be one of the most important votes I cast. After attending every debate, and having my own amendments accepted, I voted for the Bill. For me, with good safeguards in the Bill, this came down to providing choice. This Bill will now move to the House of Lords

I welcome Labour's 10-Year Health Plan to shift care from hospitals to communities, analogue to digital, and sickness to prevention. We have to act now to make sure our NHS is here for future generations. After hearing from a constituent cut off from her mum during the pandemic, I also spoke in Parliament about the importance of safe contact in care settings.

It's clear from local conversations that the welfare system isn't working for anyone. I've met with the relevant Minister to share local concerns. 1 in 8 young people nationally are not in employment, education or training and we cannot see a lost generation. Many people want to work but lack support - that's why Labour is introducing a 'Right to Try' and tailored back to work support. For those unable to ever work we'll always provide support and end mandatory reassessments.

Having met with the Policing Minister previously, I'm pleased our government will deliver 70 new police officers for Avon and Somerset, working with Police and Crime Commissioner Clare Moody, as part of a £200 million investment in neighbourhood policing.

Community view

I recently welcomed Blackhorse Primary students to Parliament and would love to see more local schools here in the autumn too.

Locally this month I've visited veteran-led defence SME business RC Fornax, Airbus' Family and Friends Day, joined the Mayor of Patchway to open the pollinator project at Pretoria Road Allotments, and met pioneering companies at Bristol and Bath Science Park.

It's been a pleasure to support many excellent community festivals and school fairs - from Filton to Lyde Green. Thank you to everyone involved in putting on such great events.

Police & Crime Commissioner

Summer campaign to strengthen neighbourhood policing across South Gloucestershire

You've told me you want safer streets and more visible policing and I'm doing it. I've listened to your concerns about anti-social behaviour (ASB), retail crime, and criminality in town and city centres, and I am working with the Chief Constable to put more officers where they are needed, tackling crime in high streets and areas you care about, because you should feel safe in your high street.



I have launched "Your Streets, My Priority" this month – a coordinated programme of action to enhance neighbourhood policing and create safer, more vibrant town centres and high streets across the region. There are several centres targeted across the Avon and Somerset area. The focus is on making our town and city centres safer, more vibrant spaces where residents, businesses, and visitors feel secure and welcomed.

Supported by the Neighbourhood Policing Guarantee, which has added more officers to your local teams, and the additional dedicated patrols in targeted areas, the plans will be delivering more proactive, visible and engaging policing in your cities and towns.

From increased foot patrols, to street surgeries and crime prevention advice for businesses. The local plans include ways for the police to work closer with businesses to share information, respond to incidents and target prolific offenders as well as proactive use of powers to address ASB. We will see additional partnership work with licensing colleagues to address issues relating to licensed premises as well as diversionary activities for young people, like the outreach and engagement programmes provided by the South Gloucestershire Violence Reduction Partnership (VRP). My team will also be working with partners to raise awareness of opportunities for young people.

Throughout the summer, I will be visiting different areas throughout South Gloucestershire to meet residents, businesses, community groups, and the local neighbourhood police team to see how things are progressing. I will be monitoring progress to make sure the campaign delivers results for you.

A cricket ball soundly meeting a bat immediately conjures thoughts of sun-soaked afternoons, crisp white flannels and –naturally– a refreshing tipple to top it off. Hambrook cricket club is one of Bristol's oldest; founded in 1846, the game has been played on Whiteshill Common since 1878.

In the member-subsidised bar, older members fondly recall county cricket tours. (And their associated adventures!) Three senior teams play at the club; on Friday evenings you'll find the Common filled with youngsters learning the rules of the game, surrounded by parent volunteers helping mentor, staffing the bar, or enjoying a drink in the sun. And yet, sadly, the coming winter could call time on this invaluable community asset.

"Covid really took a toll on our members," says Mitch Vardy, Club Treasurer, "Our bar used to be full of members seven days a week, with the function room calendar packed with bands, birthday parties, and even weddings. People don't realise we're still here, with the bar open on Fridays, Saturdays and match days. Then there's the cost of living, which has hit everyone hard, but our winter fuel bills are just killing us."

Hambrook Sports Club Committee recently held a forum to invite members to think of ways to save the club. "It won't take much community involvement

to keep us afloat this winter," says Dr Alastair Kilfoyl, Club Chairman, "We're working with a highly-qualified fitness instructor to offer pilates, a mother-and-baby, and a yoga wheel class to the local community during the week. What we need to get us through this winter is for more people to book the function room for events – it's perfect for kids parties, or classes. Just one extra booking a month could make all the difference. Although, we wouldn't say no to more social members coming to support the bar – so we can start getting proper craft ales in on draught!"





Rogue landlords and terrible tenants: What are your rights?

As rents continue to rise and demand for rental properties continue to increase, disputes between landlords and tenants are becoming more and more frequent.

We at AMD Solicitors are frequently instructed to deal with such disputes and set out below the answers to the questions we are most frequently

The Renters (Reform) Bill is currently in the final stages of its passage through the House of Lords. It is expected to become law upon receiving Royal Assent, with implementation anticipated in the coming months or by early 2026.

However, as the bill has not yet become law, we address below the position as the law currently stands.

Most frequent questions from Landlords:

My tenant isn't paying rent - can I evict them?

There are two options for landlords, serving a section 8 notice or a section 21 notice. It is typically not worth serving a section 8 notice unless the tenant is in arrears by at least two months, as the Court does not have to order possession and has a discretion.

If the tenant is two months in arrears, while you only need to give the tenant 14 days notice before issuing legal proceedings, the tenant may seek to defend the claim or even bring a counterclaim in response to seek to set off the arrears.

However, the service of a section 8 notice does allow for the recovery of rent arrears, which cannot be recovered by service of a section 21

Can I evict my tenant by serving a s.21 notice?

You cannot serve a section 21 notice earlier than 4 months into the tenancy, and they are only valid for 6 months. In order to serve a section 21 notice, the landlord must, prior to service of that notice:

1. Have provided the tenant with the How to Rent guide, EPC Certificate and Gas Safety Certificate, ideally at the start of the tenancy;



2. Protected any deposit paid by the tenant by placing the deposit in an authorised tenancy deposit scheme within 30 days of the start of the tenancy.

Most frequent questions from Tenants:

My landlord hasn't protected my deposit - what can I do?

Where the landlord has either protected the deposit late or not at all, the tenant can bring a claim for compensation. The Court must order the landlord to pay between 1 and 3 times the deposit.

The property is in disrepair - does my landlord have to carry out and pay for the repairs?

The tenancy agreement will usually contain clauses as to the repairs the landlord needs to carry out. However, where this is not the case, section 11 of the Landlord and Tenant Act 1985 requires the landlord to carry out certain repairs.

Winterbourne's lord of the manor Sir Thomas de Bradeston had the Barn built in 1342. On Thursday 25 September we have two talks from local historians and archaeologists - firstly about Sir Thomas himself, and then about the lost chantry chapel he founded at Breadstone (ie.
