# Thomas the Tomte and the Reindeer


# A new book by local author Freddie Hillberg

# An update from Clare Moody -

# **Police & Crime Commissioner**

'Your Streets, My Priority' is a coordinated programme of action I'm overseeing to enhance neighbourhood policing and create safer, more vibrant town centres and high streets across the region.

You've told me you want safer streets and more visible policing, and I'm doing it. I've listened to your concerns about anti-social behaviour, retail crime, and criminality in town centres. I'm working with the Chief Constable to put more officers where they are needed, tackling crime in high streets and areas you care about, because you should feel safe in your high street.

Over the summer, I have visited many places and have seen and heard the impact this work is having on people and their high streets.

Below are just a few of the policing activities that have been making a difference across South Gloucestershire:

- · Various Neighbourhood Policing teams joined forces with The Roads Policing Team, Special Constabulary, and the DVSA to conduct traffic patrols and checks throughout August around Easter Compton, Bradley Stoke, Winterborne Road, Yate, and Chipping Sodbury. Numerous offences were dealt with including one vehicle being found with multiple defects, no insurance, and the driver was arrested for drug driving and possession of cannabis. Another driver attempted to evade police - but the vehicle was successfully located and seized for no insurance.
- I joined South Gloucestershire Council and South Gloucestershire Neighbourhood Policing Team on the Bristol and Bath Railway Path, carrying out highly visible patrols and engaging with users of the path about their feelings of safety.
- The deployment of plainclothes officers at The Mall, Cribbs Causeway, as part of Project Servator - which is all about unpredictable, highly visible police deployments designed to disrupt criminal activity while reassuring the public. You'll see a mix of uniformed and plain clothes officers, working together with security staff and the local community to keep everyone safe.
- In addition to all the policing activity that has continued throughout the summer, there have also been community stalls and pop-ups happening, so our police and partners can hear from people about any issues they are facing.

On 9th September I held a public forum at Chipping Sodbury Golf Club, offering members of the public the opportunity to engage directly with me and senior officers from the Local Policing Team. I am here to listen and represent local communities, so it was great to see so many people engaged and sharing their views.

Topics discussed included concerns around anti-social behaviour (ASB) and issues around motorcycle theft, resulting in a follow-up meeting dedicated to bike theft in South Gloucestershire.

# Local BMX Star on Track for Oz

Local BMX star, Eliza French (15), will be travelling to Brisbane, Australia next year as a member of the GB BMX team at the World Championships.

Eliza, from Bradley Stoke, has been racing since 2020 as a member of the Bristol Jets BMX club based at Patchway and in 2024 was signed by the BRE Racing Team, a national BMX team.

She progressed through the South-West Regional series and in 2024 took part in the National Series for the first time, finishing 13th. As a result, she qualified to represent GB at the World Championships in Copenhagen this summer.

Eliza participated in the 'Deep South' Winter series between October 2024 and March 2025. This was her first time in this series, and she finished in 1st place in the Girls 15-16 age group.

Eliza then took part in the South region summer series having won the South West region three years in a row. The South region races typically have twice the number of entrants, visit a number of National-level tracks and also put her against girls who she will race in the National Series. She finished in 3rd place in the South series, against stiff competition.

In the 2025 British Cycling National Series, Eliza has made fantastic progress. At the start of the season her objective for the year was to make an 'A' final at some point, having never achieved this in 2024. Well, she made the 'A' final at the very first attempt in round 1 and kept going! 2025 also saw her take her first moto (heat) win, a feat she then repeated two more times! She finished the National series in 7th place overall, up from 13th last year and consequently has qualified to

represent GB again. this time in the 2026 BMX World Championships in Brisbane!

Eliza has also been invited to join the British **Cycling BMX Talent** 



Development Pathway Regional School of Racing

At the end of August Eliza became 2025 South-West Region champion in the 17-29 years female class. (Bear in mind she is only 15!).

In the British BMX Championships, she did well and is now officially National #7 (overall result from 10 rounds of the national series), and British # 5 (result from the single event at the British Championships a few weeks

Eliza currently trains on track three times a week with qualified coaches, goes to a local gym several times a week before school and has race meetings around the country most weekends. She is a student at Abbeywood Community School where she is studying for her GCSEs. Amongst other subjects, she is taking a BTEC in Sport and hopes to make a career in a sportsrelated profession. She is also a budding musician and a talented young drummer!

Amazing effort Eliza - Congratulations on all you achievements!

# Rob bounces back from prostate cancer with 3.622-mile unsupported bike ride across 10 states of the USA

Avid cyclist Rob Brinkman was planning a 4,000-mile unsupported race across 10 states of the USA when doctors diagnosed prostate cancer.

But 18 months later, Rob, aged 59, has bounced back from having his prostate removed to overcome unforgiving terrain and temperatures, countless punctures, navigation equipment failure, and even snakes, to finish the challenging event - raising over £4,000 (and counting) for Prostate Cancer UK, which champions radical improvements in the diagnosis, treatment and prevention of the illness and support for people with it.

This summer Rob completed 3,622 miles across 10 states in 28 days, averaging 131 miles a day, sometimes through mountainous terrain for days on end, mostly using Google maps after the route files he downloaded in preparation for the race failed to load despite three attempts.

He was competing in the trans-American non-stop race from Astoria, Oregon, on the west coast and finishing in Washington DC in the east, finding places to stay on an ad-hoc basis, sometimes camping, and buying equipment and provisions along the way.

Rob, a spin class instructor at Bradley Stoke and Thornbury Active Lifestyle Centres, where colleagues and members have been following his exploits, says: "Since I got back, the realisation of what I've achieved has begun to sink in. Some of the older members have been saying well done, while some of the younger ones have been telling me I'm mad!"

Rob says he would do the race again 'without a

shadow of a doubt', citing the camaraderie among those taking part as the standout experience, which easily eclipses the challenges of the terrain and the weather. "You could be cycling with somebody for five minutes and you're finding out their life story. They want to talk because, like you, they might not have seen anybody else for days on end,' says father-of-two Rob.

"No matter which route you take, it's challenging - psychologically and physically - because of the nature



Rob: "Prostate cancer is very personal to me as I got diagnosed with it in 2023 after having zero symptoms. After talking to friends and listening to the radio I took a PSA test. It took 5 months from the first test to laying in the recovery room having had my prostate taken out.

"I have made a good recovery, I had set targets and was determined it would not impede my life going forward. There are some side effects that do get discussed preop and some that do not, overall they are manageable but you have to remain positive even in the darkest

"Life going forward is definitely a game changer, you have to have a positive mindset and be prepared for these changes...but we are still alive and we are still kicking !!"

of the terrain, the weather systems and the vast expanse of nothing. You could go for 150 miles and see nothing, not even a cow."

"The first day was relatively easy, even though it was 160 miles, it was nice and flat and there's a couple of hills, but nothing to worry about. Then it starts getting challenging, because you're starting to go up into the Rockies. Some hills took four or five hours and you're still climbing, and it's like, what's going

on? Then there's the rolling hills of Nebraska, just four or five days of rolling hills with a prairie headwind. A Prairie wind is like an industrial hair dryer. No gusts, it's just constant wind in your face. It's desert heat too, you're drinking your water, and because it's such a dry heat, your throat is constantly dry, even after knocking back a litre bottle of water, which is getting hot because of the ambient temperature."

Saved from despair by two pints of tea! One of the most memorable stretches – for good and bad reasons - was the 300 miles of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal towpath and the Great Allegheny Passage trail from Pittsburgh to Washington DC, says Rob.

It was there he had to camp in mosquito-riddled woods and encountered snakes, one of them slithering alongside his sleeping bag.

"It was muddy on some stretches and then poorly maintained in some parts, which was puncturing my tvres." explains Rob.

"The heat was humid, and it was murder in the mud and then trying to change punctures while getting bitten by mosquitos.

"But about four hours later, I'd stopped for a burrito, and I saw a box of tea bags. I hadn't had a cup of tea for about five or six days, because they don't drink tea over there much.

"So, I sat there with two pints of tea and the world suddenly felt all right again. This is good, I thought, this is challenging but I turned that negative into a positive with two pints of tea. It was brilliant!"

Rob is now in training to replace the stone in weight he lost while crossing the USA to compete in another sport he loves - indoor rowing - at the British indoor rowing championships up at the NEC in Birmingham, where he'll be in the 2000-metre race.

# Why use a Solicitor to obtain Probate and Administer the Estate of someone who has died?

After someone dies, their affairs are finalised by their Personal Representative ('PR') who would either be appointed in their Will or under general law if there is no will. It is open to any PR to try to deal with the estate themselves, but very often there will be complexities which is why a solicitor should be instructed.

The rest of this article will assume you are the PR and set out reasons why you may wish to do this:-

The first reason is that after a loved one has died. it is an extremely difficult and emotional time, yet you would have to deal with a great deal of paperwork and responsibility. Do you even know where to start?

You would have personal liability for any mistakes you make which caused a financial loss to those inheriting. This could include not collecting in certain assets or paying tax on time. You would have to put your hand into your own pocket to make good those losses.

Wills are legal documents and inevitably their language is legal. It can be hard to understand and Wills do tend to be written by lawyers for lawyers.

You would need to know whether or not a Grant of Probate would be needed in your estate. You would need to know what this is and whether a different type of Grant might be needed.

There can be many different sorts of tax which come into play in an estate, including Inheritance Tax, Capital Gains Tax and Income Tax. You may need to value the estate extremely accurately, report to HMRC and arrange for it to be paid. Penalties and interest can be applied if you are at fault.

Dealing with someone's affairs after they have died can be lengthy and extremely time consuming. You may have to do this in your spare time when you are not working or dealing with other family issues.

Emotions often run high after a death. Family members may criticise you (perhaps wrongly) for not dealing with matters quickly enough or

keeping them informed. They may claim that you are making mistakes and that you have not, for example, obtained the best price for an asset. Leaving matters with a solicitor could avoid all this.

It is your duty at the end to prepare detailed estate accounts, ie figures showing the assets received and liabilities paid out, together with information on tax, changes in values, amounts going to different beneficiaries etc. These can be very complicated, but a solicitor would know how to prepare them, down to the last penny.






